Youth Programs at WAS: Summer Camps for 1900 kids ages 4-18 and school year programs for 300 kids ages 4-18. Deep nature connection and healthy people connection is our mission.

Job Description:

- 1.) Instruct one or more school year monthly youth programs

Compensation:

Part-Time Roles at Monthlies:

Core Monthlies Instructors - These staff will be Instructors or Lead Instructors 1-2 days per week for Friday and/or Saturday Monthly Programs at Seattle area parks. This is a 10-20 hour per week contract position, paid by the hour, requiring one planning meeting per week with the Monthlies teaching team (either on Monday or Tuesday).

Peripheral Monthlies Instructors - These staff will be Instructors 1-2 days per month for Friday and/or Saturday Monthly Programs at Seattle area parks. This person would not attend weekly staff meetings, and would receive orientation to the teaching team plan by email or at the planning meeting on the morning of program. This is a 8-16 hour per week contract position, paid by the hour, requiring NO planning meetings.

Please note that candidates who can work more hours and who can commit to the whole season (Sept-May) will receive preference.
